Below are answers to some of our frequently asked questions

Soroptimist International of Murray Bridge annual Scholarship is open to both male and female applicants.

The Scholarship is open to all Yr 12 students in the Murraylands who have **applied** to be accepted into tertiary study.

Interviews will generally be held in mid January of the year following completion of Year 12.

If the successful applicant decides to take a "gap" year, the scholarship funds will be held in trust for one year only. If, after one year the successful applicant wishes to defer longer the scholarship will be forfeited.

This is an "all-rounder" scholarship based on academic results, community involvement, personal development/life experiences and performance at interview.
