SCHOLARSHIP TYPES

ACADEMIC SCHOLARSHIPS

Academic Scholarships are awarded to students of exceptional academic ability and potential across a broad range of disciplines.

Selection is based on academic assessment results and, where applicable, interview performance. Successful candidates demonstrate a strong commitment to learning and a willingness to engage in the wide range of opportunities available at Unity College.

Applications for 2027 entry are currently open.

EXCELLENCE SCHOLARSHIPS

Excellence Scholarships recognise students who demonstrate outstanding achievement in one of the following areas:

- + Football
- + Netball

Selection is based on academic attitude, achievement, work ethic, community involvement and leadership potential with a competitive high level of participation in their sport (at association level)

Applications for 2027 entry are currently open.

UNITY FOUNDATION SCHOLARSHIPS

Unity College is grateful for the generosity of benefactors whose gifts provide transformational educational opportunities for students.

Provides financial assistance for students who would not otherwise be able to attend Unity College. Successful and eligible applications will meet with our Finance Team before offering the scholarship.

PERSONAL ENDEAVOUR SCHOLARSHIP (YEARS 3 & 5)

The Personal Endeavour Scholarship recognises and encourages students who demonstrate a strong work ethic and consistent excellence in academic achievement, community service and leadership.

Applicants must be entering Years 3 & 5 in 2027 to be eligible (new enrolments only).

Applications for 2027 entry are currently open.

SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATIONS

Applications for 2027 scholarships are currently open.

Unity College offers a broad range of enrichment scholarships, including:

- + **Academic Scholarships**
- + **Excellence Scholarships** (across netball/football)
- + **Personal Endeavour Scholarships** (Years 3 & 5 - *New Enrolments ONLY*)
- + **Unity Foundation Scholarships** (Years Reception, 7 & 10 - *New Enrolments ONLY*)

These scholarships recognise students who demonstrate exemplary character, commitment, and potential to contribute positively to the life of the College.

Scholarships are available to both new and current students and are offered at specific year levels depending on the scholarship type and eligibility criteria.

APPLICATION PROCESS

Applications for scholarships are to be made by completing and returning an application form, including a written statement (of at least 500 words) from the student outlining their past achievements and future goals. For those applying for the Academic Scholarship, a scholarship examination will be held on **Friday 9 October 2026 at 1pm.**

Supporting evidence should be included with the application and may consist of one or more of the following:

- + School reports from previous two years
- + NAPLAN reports
- + Copies of academic certificates of achievement
- + Copies of sporting, music or other certificates of achievement
- + A reference from either a past teacher, Pastor, coach or mentor.

SELECTION CRITERIA

The following criteria will determine a successful applicant:

- + Unity College scholarship examination results (for academic)
- + Demonstrated consistently strong academic performance in most subjects (academic records)
- + Active involvement in co-curricular activities which may include, but are not limited to sport, culture and community
- + Leadership roles within the current school or wider community
- + Outstanding personal qualities
- + Positive contribution to the current school community in a variety of ways
- + An interview with the Principal for short-listed applicants.

Scholarship recipients are expected to consistently strive for personal excellence and act as positive role models within the College and wider community.

All scholarship holders are required to meet agreed expectations outlined in individual scholarship documentation.

- + **Academic Examination (Academic Scholarship):**

- + **Scholarship Outcomes Announced:** November 2026
