Unity College Personal Endeavour Scholarships recognise and encourage students who demonstrate a strong work ethic, a commitment to learning, leadership potential, and consistent academic achievement.

These scholarships celebrate students who contribute positively to their school community, strive to achieve their personal best, and embody the values of Unity College.

ELIGIBILITY

To be eligible for a Unity College Personal Endeavour Scholarship, applicants must be:

- + A new student entering Year 3 and/or Year 5.

Applicants must also be:

- + Australian or New Zealand citizens, or
- + Holders of an Australian Permanent Resident Visa.

As part of the application process, all applicants will be required to provide evidence of academic achievement, leadership and community involvement (sport etc).

SELECTION CRITERIA

Selection for a Personal Endeavour Scholarship is based on:

- + Consistently high academic achievement
- + Demonstrated commitment to learning and personal growth
- + Positive attitude and strong work ethic
- + Leadership potential and contribution to the school community
- + Participation and engagement within school life
- + Excellent attendance record.

WHAT DOES A PERSONAL ENDEAVOUR SCHOLARSHIP COVER?

- + Scholarships may provide up to 50% remission of tuition fees.
- + Scholarship amounts may vary according to the individual applicant and demonstrated achievement.
- + In exceptional circumstances, scholarships exceeding 50% may be considered.

The scholarship applies to tuition fees only and does not include:

- + Uniforms
- + Enrolment or application fees
- + Transport
- + Laptop/ IPAD or digital devices
- + Textbooks and stationery
- + Camps, excursions, and tours
- + Co-curricular activities
- + Private instrumental or vocal tuition
- + Sundry charges or personal expenses.

SCHOLARSHIP EXPECTATIONS

All scholarship recipients are expected to:

- + Maintain a strong commitment to academic effort and personal excellence.
- + Demonstrate positive behaviour and leadership.
- + Uphold the Christian values and expectations of Unity College.
- + Participate positively in College life and opportunities.
- + Serve as positive ambassadors for the College community.

Scholarships are reviewed regularly and may be withdrawn if scholarship expectations are not maintained.

TERMS & CONDITIONS

All scholarship holders must meet several agreed expectations if they are to continue to receive the award. Scholarships will be reviewed annually. For more details about the general expectations of ALL scholarship recipients and the additional specific expectations for each type of scholarship, please review this document prior to application.

UNITY COLLEGE PERSONAL ENDEAVOUR SCHOLARSHIP TERMS AND CONDITIONS

1. ELIGIBILITY

- 1.1 To be eligible for a Unity College Personal Endeavour Scholarship, applicants must be Australian or New Zealand citizens or holders of an Australian Permanent Resident Visa and be:
 - + New students entering Year 3 and/or Year 5.
- 1.2 A student may hold only one scholarship at any given time. Additional fee reductions or discounts cannot be applied in conjunction with a scholarship.

2. SELECTION CRITERIA

- 2.1 This scholarship recognises and encourages students who demonstrate a strong work ethic and consistently excel in the following areas:
 - 2.1.1 Academic achievement and commitment to learning
 - 2.1.2 Engagement, service, and positive contribution within the College and broader community
 - 2.1.3 Leadership potential, character, and personal growth.

3. GENERAL EXPECTATIONS OF ALL UNITY COLLEGE SCHOLARSHIP HOLDERS

- 3.1 Scholarship holders are expected to act as positive role models and ambassadors for Unity College, demonstrating high standards of behaviour, leadership, presentation, and respect at all times.
- 3.2 Scholarship recipients must maintain a strong commitment to their learning through positive attitude, effort, participation, and achievement.
- 3.3 Scholarship holders are encouraged to participate actively in College life through co-curricular activities, leadership opportunities, service, and community involvement.
- 3.4 All scholarship recipients are expected to uphold and reflect the Christian values of Unity College, including integrity, compassion, inclusivity, service, and respect.
- 3.5 Families are requested to keep scholarship arrangements confidential and not discuss scholarship details outside their immediate family.
- 3.6 An annual scholarship review will be conducted to ensure recipients continue to meet the expectations and standards required by the College.
- 3.7 Failure to meet scholarship expectations may result in the scholarship not being renewed or, in serious circumstances, withdrawn immediately at the discretion of the Principal.
- 3.8 A student may hold only one College scholarship, which overrides any other fee concessions, discounts, or special arrangements.
- 3.9 Scholarship holders are expected to remain enrolled at Unity College for the duration of the scholarship period. In circumstances where a student withdraws from the College before completion of the scholarship, the College reserves the right to review the scholarship arrangement. The Principal may, at their discretion, waive or amend any repayment obligations.

4. SCHOLARSHIP AWARD AND ACCEPTANCE

- 4.1 New students accepting a scholarship will still be required to pay applicable enrolment and application fees.
- 4.2 These Terms and Conditions should be read in conjunction with the College's Student Enrolment Agreement and any other applicable College policies and procedures.

5. SCHOLARSHIP REVIEW (ANNUALLY)

- 5.1 Unity College reserves the right to review the performance, engagement, conduct, and contribution of scholarship holders at any time.
- 5.2 Scholarship holders may participate in regular progress reviews to ensure they continue to meet the expectations of the College and work towards agreed goals and standards.
- 5.3 The College reserves the right to amend, suspend, or withdraw a scholarship where the terms and conditions of the scholarship are not being met.
